SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

Calvary Baptist Church's Ministry of Christian Education is pleased to announce the offering of a scholarship that provides financial assistance to Calvary Baptist Church ("the Church") students to encourage their pursuit of a higher education. Scholarship funds may be used only for education-related expenses (e.g. tuition, fees, room and board, and/or books and materials) that directly relate to obtaining a vocational, technical, associate, bachelors or post-baccalaureate degree. Please note, awards are <u>not</u> renewable, and awards can only be conferred <u>once</u>.

CRITERIA FOR SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY

In order for a student to be considered for the scholarship, each student must submit a completed application and the required supplementary documentation (refer to page 3). Each applicant must demonstrate and meet the following requirements to the Ministry of Christian Education's satisfaction:

- 1. The applicant must be under 26 years of age.
- 2. The applicant must be enrolled and attending a public or private, not-for-profit (501(c)(3)) vocational school, technical school, community college, college, or university in the U.S. or U.S. territories on a full-time basis (at least 12 credit hours per semester).
- 3. The applicant must be maintaining an overall GPA of at least 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale) with at least 1 semester of grades posted.
- 4. The student must be or have been an active member, in good standing, of Calvary Baptist Church.
- 5. The student must be or have been a regular participant in at least one ministry (which includes Sunday school) offered by the Church during high school, undergraduate, or graduate studies.

We will begin accepting applications on **November 1**, and all completed applications must be received by **January 31** (late submissions will not be considered). Upon submission of a complete application package (*incomplete application packages* will not be considered), the Ministry of Christian Education will review the application and nominate all eligible applicants to the Pastor and Trustees for their final approvals. Based on the applications and the church's available scholarship funds, the Pastor and the Trustees will approve or modify the Ministry of Christian Education's proposed scholarship amount(s). **Please note: each scholarship amount varies, but can be granted up to \$2,000.00**. After the Pastor and Trustee Ministry's final approval, the Ministry of Christian Education will notify each applicant of the Church's decision by letter no later than February 28. Calvary Baptist Church will directly send a scholarship check to each selected recipient's financial aid office on his or her behalf.
